

To All KCR Presenters and Volunteers – COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

1. We wrote to you on 1 December 2021 concerning COVID-19 vaccination. It now appears that Western Australia State Government policy has placed Media organisations in their lowest category of risk. This means that individuals who are not vaccinated will only be excluded from KCR premises **in the event of lockdown**.
2. However, KCR still needs to have a record of who is vaccinated and who is not. This is so that we can follow the correct procedures if required. Can you please therefore inform Julie Evans, KCR Secretary, by e-mail to kcrsecretary@aussiebb.com.au by 17 January 2022 whether or not you are willing to confirm your vaccination status. This information will be kept in strict confidence.
3. Those who are willing to confirm their vaccination status are asked to complete the attached form and provide the required evidence to the KCR Secretary by 31 January 2022. Such evidence will also be kept in strict confidence.
4. Those who do not wish to confirm their vaccination status or do not wish to be vaccinated will be treated as unvaccinated in the event of a lockdown. They may also be asked to always limit their contact with other Presenters and Volunteers on KCR premises.
5. Please continue to follow all the procedures outlined in the letter of 1 December 2021 and to follow all regulations issued by the State of Western Australia from time to time regarding control of COVID-19. Please be aware that should a person who has, or is subsequently found to have COVID-19, comes to the KCR premises many Presenters may need to isolate and there may be a need for deep cleaning, an expensive process that KCR could ill afford.
